PENNSYLVANIA AMERICAN WATER ANNOUNCES \$11 MILLION WASHINGTON COUNTY SYSTEM UPGRADE

MCMURRAY, Pa. (JULY 23, 2018) – Pennsylvania American Water announced today an approximately \$11 million investment to make pipeline and water system upgrades in Washington County. The new construction includes upgrading the county’s water storage capacity and replacing almost four miles of main.

“These upgrades will improve water service reliability and fire protection for our Washington County customers,” said Pennsylvania American Water Senior Director of Operations Sean Graves. “The pipes being replaced have reached the end of their service life, with some dating back to the early to mid-1900s. The new main we’re installing is expected to last the next 100 years.”

A new 750,000-gallon water storage tank is under construction along South Hewitt Avenue in Canton Township. Work on the tank began in April. Weather permitting, the approximately \$3 million tank is expected to be in service by December 2018.

Pennsylvania American Water is also preparing to erect a new 500,000-gallon water storage tank along Stoop Drive in the City of Monongahela. The approximately \$3.2 million project will begin in mid-July and is expected to be in service by December 2018.

In addition, the company is rehabilitating a 422,000-gallon water storage tank in California Borough, which was previously rehabilitated in 1992. Crews will strip the original paint and apply a new coating to extend the lifespan of the structure located on Peach Street. The tank is expected to be back in service by December 2018.

The company expects to complete the water main upgrade, service tie-ins and final paving restoration by late November, weather permitting. During construction, customers might experience temporary water service interruptions, discolored water and/or lower than normal water pressure.
