PENNSYLVANIA AMERICAN WATER TO REPLACE AGING WATER MAIN IN SINKING SPRING

WYOMISSING, Pa. (October 10, 2018) – Pennsylvania American Water today announced the start of installation of new water main in Sinking Spring Borough to improve service reliability and prevent water outages. The project cost is approximately \$350,000 and will replace outdated cast iron pipe dating back to the 1950s.

Starting today, October 10, the company will install nearly 850 feet of new eight-inch PVC pipe along Gring Drive between Clover Avenue and Broadcasting Road. Crews expect to complete the water main installation, testing and disinfection, and connecting customers' service lines to the new main by early November, weather permitting. Final street paving restoration is scheduled for next spring.

Crews will work weekdays between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. Traffic restrictions will be in place during construction, and motorists are urged to give themselves extra time and exercise caution when traveling through the work zone. During construction, customers might experience temporary water service interruptions, discolored water and/or lower than normal water pressure.
