

## New Jersey American Water Invests \$1.3 Million in Bradley Beach Infrastructure

**CAMDEN, N.J. – FEB. 7, 2020 –** [New Jersey American Water](#) will replace approximately 4,780 feet of aging water main in Bradley Beach this winter. The project also includes replacing two fire hydrants and 79 utility-owned service lines along the pipeline route. The company will upgrade the aging water lines, installed as far back as the 1920s and as small as two inches in diameter, with new, 8-inch ductile iron main along the following streets:

- **Third Avenue** from Madison Avenue to Ocean Avenue
- **Beach Avenue** from Evergreen Avenue to Third Avenue
- **Hammond Avenue** from Evergreen Avenue to Third Avenue

This \$1.3 million investment will continue to advance water service reliability and increase water flows for household consumption and fire protection in this community. This improvement is part of New Jersey American Water's multimillion-dollar initiative to accelerate the [renewal of water infrastructure](#) that has reached the end of its useful life in more than 100 communities across the state.

New Jersey American Water's local, qualified contractor, Montana Construction Inc., will begin work on or about Feb. 14 and expects to finish by the end of March 2020, weather permitting. Work hours will be from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Work outside of these hours is not anticipated unless required to maintain project schedule. Final street restorations will be completed in late spring of 2020.

For the public's and workers' safety, traffic restrictions and/or alternating traffic patterns are likely to occur during work hours. All emergency vehicles and local traffic will be allowed access during construction. New Jersey American Water values the safety of its workers and advises drivers and pedestrians to take caution in the vicinity of work sites.
