

New Jersey American Water Invests \$942,000 in Middle Township Infrastructure

CAMDEN, N.J. – MAR. 23, 2020 – [New Jersey American Water](#) will replace approximately 2,640 feet of aging 4-inch and 6-inch water main in Middle Township beginning tomorrow. The project also includes replacing four fire hydrants and 62 utility-owned service lines along the pipeline route. The company will upgrade the aging water lines, installed as far back as the 1940s, with new 8-inch and 12-inch ductile iron main along the following streets:

- **Mechanic Street** from Poplar Street to Hamann Ave
- **Goshen Road** from Church Street to Mechanic Street
- **Dias Creek Road** from Hand Avenue to Mechanic Street

This \$942,000 investment will continue to advance water service reliability and increase water flows for household consumption and fire protection in this community. This improvement is part of New Jersey American Water's multimillion-dollar initiative to accelerate the [renewal of water infrastructure](#) that has reached the end of its useful life in more than 100 communities across the state.

New Jersey American Water's local, qualified contractor, Perna Finnigan Inc., will begin work on or about March 24 and expects to be completed by early June, weather permitting. Work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. except for at the intersection of Dias Creek Avenue and Hand Avenue, which will be overnight. All work will take place Monday through Thursday, and work outside of these hours is not expected unless required to maintain project schedule. Final street restorations will be completed in the fall of 2020.

For the public's and workers' safety, traffic restrictions and/or alternating traffic patterns are likely to occur during work hours. All emergency vehicles and local traffic will be allowed access during construction. New Jersey American Water values the safety of its workers and advises drivers and pedestrians to take caution in the vicinity of work sites.
