Indiana American Water Cuts Ribbon for Treatment Plant Upgrade in Terre Haute, Ind.

Project adds new well, replaces 95-year-old water filters

TERRE HAUTE, Ind. (June 25, 2019) – Indiana American Water, a subsidiary of American Water Company (NYSE: AWK), today released details of a nearly \$6 million upgrade to its water treatment facilities in Terre Haute, Ind. at a ribbon cutting ceremony with Terre Haute Mayor Duke Bennett, community leaders, and project partners.

“Access to plentiful, quality water resources has played a key role in the success of the Wabash Valley for many years,” said Indiana American Water President Matt Prine. “Since our company purchased the Terre Haute system nearly a century ago, we have made significant investments to ensure we are able to meet the needs of the area, and this project will allow us to continue do that in a reliable way for many years to come.”

The project includes replacing four 95-year old gravity water filters at the company’s Terre Haute water treatment facility with two new pressure filters and constructing a new well to replace older, aging wells at the end of their useful life. The new filters will provide 4.5 million gallons per day of treatment capacity. The filters are located in a building addition that was constructed so it can be easily expanded as future demand requires additional capacity. Five existing pressure filters are already in use at the plant. The new well will be able to produce 3 million gallons of water per day.

Indiana American Water has invested nearly \$56 million over the last decade in its water infrastructure in the area, including more than \$16 million to replace/relocate water mains and fire hydrants, more than \$17 million to install/replace service lines and water meters, and more than \$22 million in its pumping, treatment, capacity and operations facilities.
