New Jersey American Water Investing \$500,000 in Riverside

CAMDEN, N.J. (March 7, 2019) – [New Jersey American Water](#) is replacing approximately 2,500 feet of aging water main in its Riverside service area. The company is replacing water main that was installed in the 1930s with new ductile iron main along **Heulings Avenue**, from New Jersey Avenue to West Washington Street. The project includes replacing one fire hydrant and 83 utility-owned service lines along the pipeline route.

This \$500,000 investment will continue to improve water service reliability and increase water flows for household consumption and fire protection in this community. This improvement is part of New Jersey American Water's multimillion dollar program to accelerate the [renewal of water infrastructure](#) that is reaching the end of its useful life in more than 100 communities across the state.

New Jersey American Water's local qualified contractor, Pioneer Pipe Contractors, LLC, will begin work next week and be completed by the end of April, weather permitting. Work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. Work outside of these hours is not expected unless required to maintain project schedule. Final street restorations on will be completed in the summer 2019.

For the public's and workers' safety, traffic restrictions and/or alternating traffic patterns are likely to occur during work hours. All emergency vehicles and local traffic will be allowed access during construction. New Jersey American Water values the safety of its workers and advises drivers and pedestrians to take caution in the vicinity of work sites.
